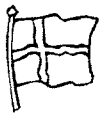

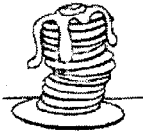

"There is a Time"

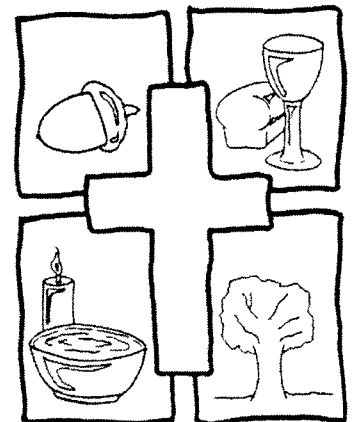

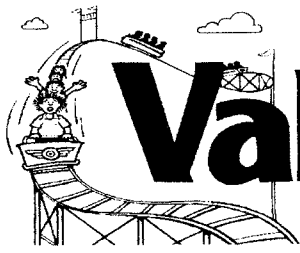
That there is a time to simply sit in the shade. It's a chance to watch the light dance and feel the breeze on your face.

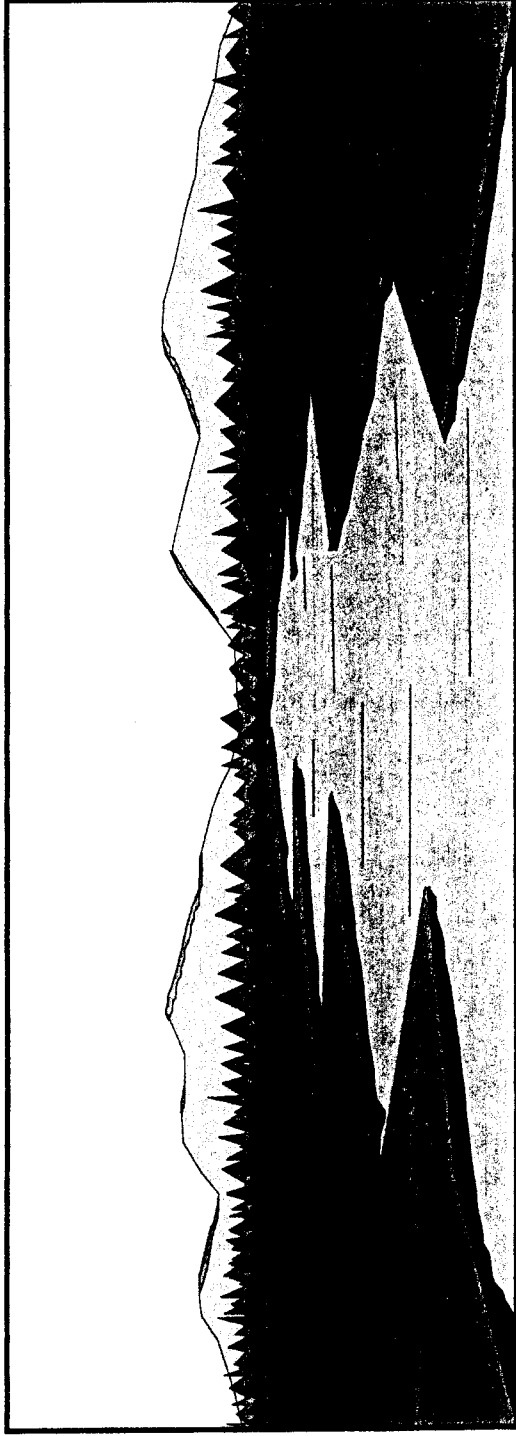

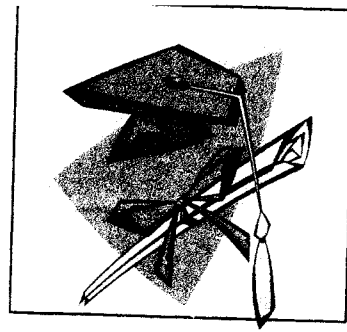
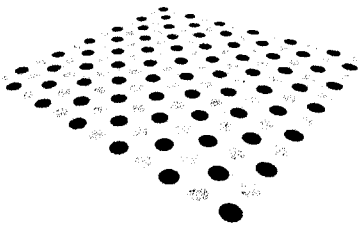
